1. **PROMISE** → The Promise of the Seed of the Woman

Genesis 3:14-15 creation-fall-curse-promise – for faith and hope in the coming seed SEED = means one and many – "one" is Jesus and "many" are the descendants

Genesis 15:6 justification by faith

Genesis 22:9-19 the promise of salvation – the LORD will provide the substitute YAHWEH-jireh = the LORD will provide" – near for Isaac – far for all in Christ

2 Samuel 7:12-13 the promise of kingdom – the LORD will provide the son-King

2. **SALVATION** → The Promise of the Savior

Matthew 1:18-25 Jesus will save His people from their sins

Matthew 21:9 "Hosanna = "save now, help now" – the King is David's son

Psalm 118:19-29 "my salvation" (21) – "do save" (25)

3. **KINGDOM** → The Promise of the King

Luke 1:26-38 Jesus will establish his authority and dominion forever **Isaiah 9:6-7** "no end of His government" – "on David's throne" – "over his kingdom"
